Kimmi Clark Lewis is a cattle producer from the Purgatoire River Canyonlands of Southeast Colorado, where she and her six children run 300 head on 18,000 acres.

Mrs. Lewis is past President of the Colorado Independent Cattle Grower's Association, the Southern Colorado Livestock Association and she currently chairs the National Private Property Rights Committee for R-CALF USA.

Mrs. Lewis recently organized the Southeast Colorado Private Property Rights Council and successfully opposed a national heritage designation by non-governmental agencies and the US Government. She has been a strong advocate against the US Army Pinon Canyon Maneuver Site expansion, located west of her ranch.

Mrs. Lewis lost her husband, Dave, to leukemia in 2000 and she herself is a breast cancer survivor.
