Martha graduated from George Mason University for undergraduate and George Mason School of law, where she received her Juris Doctor and also attended the Strauss Institute at Pepperdine University School of Law.

She founded Piedmont Agriculture Academy and Liberty Hall Livestock Rescue, as well as serving on the Board of Directors for Virginia Independent Consumer & Farmers Association and Small Family Farm Foundation. She represented Farm to Consumer Legal Foundation – advocating legislation – and is a strong supporter of farm advocacy organizations and a member of various Farm and Property Rights advocacy groups. Two bills were named after her in Virginia’s General Assembly - Boneta Bill I and Boneta Bill II. Martha sits on a Congressional Property Rights Caucus Roundtable with national leaders concerning property rights
